## LIST OF OUTSOURCED SERVICES

With the constant aim of improving service quality, AXA Assurances Luxembourg S.A. et AXA Assurances Vie Luxembourg S.A. In this respect, each subcontractor is required to sign and comply with a strict confidentiality agreement issued by the Companies, involving in particular compliance with insurance secrecy (article 300 of the December 7, 2015 law on the insurance sector). Some subcontractors also benefit from PSF (Professionnel du Secteur Financier) certification issued by the CSSF (Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier).

Insurance policy data may include, but is not limited to, the following information: insurance policy account number(s), insurance policy value, all types of transactions (surrender and payment, policy settlement, transfer of rights, etc.), origin of assets, origin of wealth, insurance policy status statements, etc.
